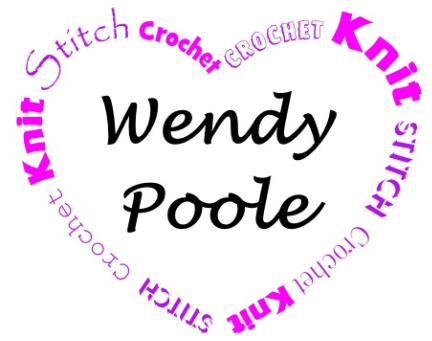


Olivers's Scarf

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A very simple and basic scarf classic scarf with two size options.

A:- slimmer longer length (as pictured) to wear doubled-up and looped around the neck

B:- A slightly broader and shorter length for a more classic look

Materials

1 x 200 gram ball of:-

"James. C. Brett"

Marble Chunky - Knitting yarn.

This pattern knits to a standard UK chunky weight yarn.

1 pair of 7mm knitting needles.

APPROXIMATE SIZE

Option A:- Width 6" (15cm), Length 74" (188cms).

Option B:- Width 7" (17.5cm), Length 68" (173cm).

TENSION

18 stitches and 19 rows approximately using 7mm needles.

Tension only approximate and isn't vital for the scarf.

INSTRUCTIONS

Version A: Cast on 34 stitches.

Version B: Cast on 38 stitches.

All rows - Slip 1, *knit 2, purl 2, repeat from * to last stitch, knit 1.

Repeat this row until your work measures approximately:

Version A:- 74" (188cm).

Version B:- 68" (173cm).

Cast off.

Darn in ends.
