



## Simple Super Chunky Crochet Scarf

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Measurements = Length – 122cm (48")  
approx, width 18cm (7") approx.

Materials = 4 x 50gram balls of Sirdar  
Big Softie, (or any alternative Super  
Chunky weight yarn).  
Approximately 180 metres of yarn  
needed in total.

9mm crochet hook.

Tension (not vital)  
4 rows = 10cm (4")  
7 stitches = 10cm (4")

Instructions are using UK Terminology

Make 16 chain, turn.

**Next row** = Miss 3 chain and make 1  
treble in 4<sup>th</sup> chain from hook, Treble to  
end of row (13 Stitches total).  
Make 3 chain and turn.

Repeat this row until you have reached 117cm (46")

***Turn and work shell edging on the 13 stitches as follows:***

Make 1 double crochet in 1<sup>st</sup> stitch, miss 2 stitches, Make 7 double trebles all  
in the next stitch (this will form the 1<sup>st</sup> shell), miss 2 stitches, make 1 double  
crochet in next stitch, miss 2 stitches Make 7 double trebles all in the next  
stitch (this will form the 2<sup>nd</sup> shell), miss 2 stitches, make 1 double crochet in  
next stitch, fasten off.

Re-join yarn to bottom corner of scarf and repeat.
