## MATERIALS

Any combination of colours can be used, with any yarn weight and correlating size hook. Materials for my blanket are listed below.

Yarn:- UK double Knitting Yarn.
5 shades of Stylecraft DK Yarn (100 gram balls), were used for the blanket photographed.
Hook size:- 4 mm hook

## MEASUREMENTS

Length:- Width/ length:- 500 grams will allow for 40 " ( 100 cm ), measured across.

## TENSION

Width:- 22 stitches $=10 \mathrm{~cm}$. Length:- 11 rows.

INSTRUCTIONS

## This pattern uses UK crochet stitch terms

Always work in the same direction with the right side of the work facing you.

## Notes

3 chain counts as 1 treble at beginning of the round.

Join rounds with slip stitch to top of the 3 chain made at the beginning of the round.

If you are starting with a new colour at the beginning of a round, join the yarn in the new colour in the stitch after the $\underline{2}$ stitch gap at any bottom dip.


If you are using the same colour at the beginning of a round, slip stitch into the next stitch, then start the new round.

## Special abbreviations

Cluster $=$ Make 2 treble, 2 chain, 2 treble, into the 2 chain space at the point.

## TO START

## Foundation Ring - Make 5 chain and join with a slip stitch.

Round 1 - Make 4 chain (this counts as 1 treble and 1 chain).
*Make 1 treble, 1 chain. Repeat from * 8 times and join with a slip stitch to the $3^{\text {rd }}$ chain made at the beginning of the round.

You should now have 10 chain spaces. Fasten off.

## Round 2 - This Round is working into the chain spaces.

Join in new colour to any chain space. Make 3 chain (This represents the $1^{\text {st }}$ stitch). Make 1 more treble in the same chain space, make 2 chain.
*In next chain space, make 2 treble and 2 chain. Repeat from * to end of round. Join with a slip stitch to $3^{\text {rd }}$ chain made at the beginning of the round.

## Check you should have 10 chain spaces. Fasten off.

## Round 3 - This Round is working into the chain spaces.

Join in new colour to any chain space. Make 1 chain. Make 2 double crochet in the same chain space, make 3 chain.
*In next chain space, make 2 double crochet and 3 chain. Repeat from * to end of round. Join with a slip stitch to $1^{\text {st }}$ double crochet made at the beginning of the round.

## Check you should have 10 chain spaces. Fasten off.

Round 4 - Join in new colour to any 3 chain space. Make 3 chain (This represents the $1^{\text {st }}$ treble stitch). Make 1 treble, 2 chain, then 2 more treble, all in the same chain space.

## JUMP TO THE NEXT CHAIN SPACE

*Make 2 treble, 2 chain, then 2 more treble, all in the same chain space (cluster made). Rep from * to end of round. Join with a slip stitch to the $3^{\text {rd }}$ chain made at the beginning of the round.

## DO NOT FASTEN OFF.

Round 5 - Make a slip stitch in the top of the $1^{\text {st }}$ treble, to move your working yarn along 1 stitch.

Make 3 chain (This represents the $1^{\text {st }}$ treble stitch). Make 2 treble, 2 chain, then 2 more treble, all in the chain space. Then make 1 treble in the next stitch after the chain space.
*Miss the next 2 stitches, (this will create the dip), make 1 treble in the next stitch leading up to the point. Work 2 treble, 2 chain, then 2 more treble, all in the same chain space. Then make 1 treble in the stitch after the chain space.

Repeat from * to end of round. Join with a slip stitch to the $3^{\text {rd }}$ chain made at the beginning of the round. Fasten off.

Round 6 - Join in new colour into the $2^{\text {nd }}$ stitch before any point.
Make 3 chain (This represents the $1^{\text {st }}$ treble stitch). Work 1 treble into the next stitch. You will now be at the point chain space.

Make 2 treble, 2 chain, then 2 more treble, all in the chain space. Then work 2 trebles after the point chain space back down towards the dip.
*Miss the next 2 stitches, (this will create the dip), then make 2 trebles leading up to the next point.

Work 2 treble, 2 chain, then 2 more treble, all in the same chain space. Then work 2 trebles after the point chain space back down towards the dip. Repeat from * to end of round.

Join with a slip stitch to the $3^{\text {rd }}$ chain made at the beginning of the round. Do not fasten off.

Round 7 - Make a slip stitch in the top of the $1^{\text {st }}$ treble, to move your working yarn along 1 stitch.

Make 3 chain (This represents the $1^{\text {st }}$ treble stitch). Work 2 trebles. You will now be at the point chain space.

Make 2 treble, 2 chain, then 2 more treble, all in the chain space. Then work 3 trebles after the point chain space back down towards the dip.
*Miss the next 2 stitches, (this will create the dip), then make 3 trebles leading up to the next point.

Work 2 treble, 2 chain, then 2 more treble, all in the same chain space. Then work 3 trebles after the point chain space back down towards the dip.

Repeat from * to end of round.
Join with a slip stitch to the $3^{\text {rd }}$ chain made at the beginning of the round. Fasten off.

## Round 8 - Join in new colour into the 4th stitch before any point

Make 3 chain (This represents the $1^{\text {st }}$ treble stitch). Work 3 trebles. You will now be at the point chain space.

Make 2 treble, 2 chain, then 2 more treble, all in the chain space. Then work 4 trebles after the point chain space back down towards the dip.
*Miss the next 2 stitches, (this will create the dip), then make 4 trebles leading up to the next point.

Work 2 treble, 2 chain, then 2 more treble, all in the same chain space. Then work 4 trebles after the point chain space back down towards the dip.

Repeat from * to end of round.
Join with a slip stitch to the $3^{\text {rd }}$ chain made at the beginning of the round.
Continue the pattern as established, (always missing the 2 stitches in each dip) and having 1 more treble between the points and dips on each round.

Carry on until work from the centre to outer point measures 20 " 51 cm ] or desired size.

Fasten off and darn in ends.
